

Erving Board of Health
Regulations for Catering and Baking Establishments, Operators of Mobile Food Carts
SUMMARY

The Erving Board of Health, acting under the authority conferred by M.G.L c.111, §31., has enacted the following regulations governing the operation of any Mobile Food Cart, or Mobile Food Vendor, or Temporary Food Vendor in the Town of Erving:

Any operator of a Mobile Food Cart or Mobile Food Vendor, or Temporary Food Vendor shall comply with prevailing regulations for said operations, and be issued a license and inspected by the Board of Health prior to start up of said operation, and have completed a Food Safety Course as mandated by the State. The vendor shall provide the Board or its Agent with a completed Application for Mobile Food Vendor Permit (form to be issued by the Board of Health) and an application fee of \$25.00.

Any operator of a Bakery or Catering Operation shall comply with prevailing regulations for said operations, and be issued a license and have the kitchen facility inspected by the Board of Health prior to start up of said operation. The “Person in Charge” shall be named and shall have completed a Food Safety Course as mandated by the State. The owner/operator shall provide the Board or its Agent with a completed Application for a Food Establishment Permit (form to be issued by the Board of Health) and an application fee of \$25.00 for each of any of the above licenses.

Non-compliance with any prevailing local, state or/and federal statutes, rules or regulations shall be cause for revocation or suspension of said license.
