Erving Board of Health Regulations for Public and Semi-Public Swimming Pool Facilities SUMMARY

The Erving Board of Health, acting under the authority conferred by M.G.L. c.111, §31, has enacted the following regulations governing the operation of any public or semi-public swimming pool or spa in the Town of Erving:

The Board of Health requires any owner/operator of a public or semi-public swimming pool or spa to complete an application for such pool or spa on a form provided by the Board of Health, and submit the fee of \$50.00 for the license for one calendar year. The Owner/Operator shall designate a Certified Pool Operator who has undertaken the state certified training and passed the requirements to be certified as such. If the pool is to not have a life guard on duty, as per state regulations, the owner/operator shall apply in writing to the Board of Health for a variance to have no lifeguard on duty.

The License may be issued by the Board or the Board's Agent(s) after an initial inspection approval, with inspections of the facility shall be made twice a calendar year, as per the regulations in the State Sanitary Code. Non-compliance with the prevailing local, state and/or federal statutes, rules or regulations shall be cause for revocation or suspension of said license.
