The town of Erving had two libraries established in 1882, and consolidated down to one library in 2004. While consolidating has allowed for an expansion of services, the current space prevents further growth. The current library building was built in 1961 and offers only 700 sq. ft. of useable space for library services. A proposed new building located near the elementary school and senior/community center will be equipped with study areas, quiet spaces, gathering spots, and a business center with high-tech tools, as well as natural light and comfortable seating areas.
