


Potential Amenities


Programming Suggestions

- Accessibility and inclusivity

Veterans Memorial Field Suggestions

Zilinski Field Suggestions

- Add a pavilion at Zilinski and more shade by the playground
- Maintenance on the walking trail in the woods at Zilinski
- Renovate bathrooms at Vets and Zilinski
- One person concerned about removing baseball from the park entirely
- Keep the tennis court at Zilinski



"I don't really like any of the options for Zilinski Field. None make great use of the space or improve upon what is already offered there. I would keep the tennis, baseball and soccer fields mostly as they are, they could be shifted so the playground is closer to the parking area and restrooms. Add a pavilion because there is so little shade there, update the play structure, add splash pad, keep up and add to the walking trail in the wooded area for dog walkers/hikers that use it to access the state forest trails, add a bike path around the perimeter of the field with some workout equipment"

Park Street Park Feedback

- Do not add a garden at Park Street
- Add the playground 2-6 and 1 more slide by keep everything else the same
